

SIMD 20: 1 Academic Year Free Accommodation Offer

Dear All,

We hope you are safe and well, and adjusting to the return to online learning for schools. We are writing on behalf of our Widening Access & Articulation Team about an offer that may be of interest to your pupils.

The University of Aberdeen is delighted to be able to offer a year's free accommodation to new undergraduate students from an SIMD20 (Quintile 1) home postcode*. This offer applies to students starting at the University in September 2021.

Free accommodation places will be available in University owned Halls of Residence. Most of our accommodation is based within <u>Hillhead Student Village</u> located near the Old Aberdeen campus.

SIMD stands for Scottish Index of Multiple Deprivation. The University uses various metrics for contextualised admissions and widening access: one of these being if an applicant normally resides in an SIMD 20 (also commonly referred to as SIMD Quintile 1) postcode area. Postcodes in these areas are considered by the Scottish Government to be among the most deprived in Scotland.

Your pupils can check if their home postcode is in a SIMD 20 (Quintile 1) postcode area on the Scottish Government website.

To check a postcode please download and open the SIMD 2020v2 Postcode Lookup (5.5MB) Excel file, then type the postcode into the column called Enter Your Postcode Below. Eligible postcodes will appear as '1' in the column titled 'SIMD 2020v2 Quintile'.
