## Dress code and uniform: Why Wear it?

- a) It gives pupils a pride and sense of belonging to our school.
- b) It creates a very positive impression for anyone meeting our pupils.
- c) It improves school security by making it easier to identify intruders.
- d) It gives pupils a sense of equality.
- e) It encourages a state of mind in pupils which improves their focus on learning and personal development.

### Dress Code

- Plain top – this may be a sweatshirt or cardigan, zip-up top or hoodies (black, white or red). School logo is preferred. Any other logo/design must not be larger than school logo.
- Plain polo shirt, shirt or blouse (black, white or red).
- Black trousers, skirt or shorts (respectable length)
- School bag with appropriate content

### Uniform

- Plain shirt or blouse (white, red or black) with a collar
- School tie
- Black trousers, skirt or shorts (respectable length)
- Plain top, jumper, cardigan (black, white or red)
- School bag with appropriate content
