



## Family Learning Q&A's

The Questions and answers are as follows:

### **Does the library membership carry on in S1 from primary school?**

Yes, all children who are a member of the library will use the same library card as they had from the public library in the school library. Aberdeenshire Libraries in an integrated service so pupils can borrow items from the public library and the school library and also return their items to any library in Aberdeenshire. If a child is not a member before coming to the academy a borrower record will be created for them letting the access the same resources as every other pupil.

### **How do you get your library PIN?**

You can reset your PIN online if you don't know it or have forgotten it
