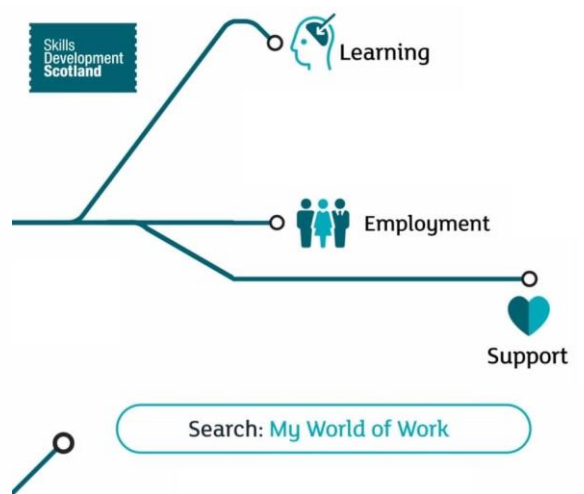

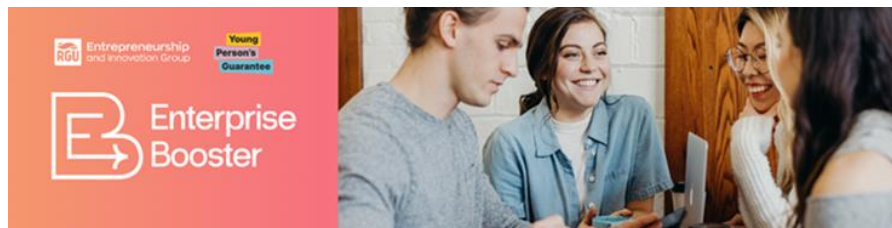

Learning, training and opportunities:

DIGITAL SKILLS PIPELINE - APPLICATIONS OPEN

The Digital Skills Pipeline is open for applications. There is currently a high demand for digital skills and this is a great chance to develop yours.

Learners are grouped into 2 broad categories.

The Support category is for those who have basic digital skills and want to learn about careers in technology.

The Create category is for people with more advanced digital skills. They may not be thinking about working in technology but are likely to be more aware of what roles exist.

To be eligible to apply, you'll need to be resident in Scotland and have the right to work in the UK and be 25 years and over.
