## What is Family Learning?

Family learning encourages family members to learn together as and within a family, with a focus on learning across the generations. Learning doesn't stop when you leave school, we are all continually learning new things throughout our lives, this is just another way.

Family learning activities can also be specifically designed to enable parents to learn how to support their children's learning. They give parents and carers the opportunity to find out how things are taught in their own child's school, as well as a chance to share ideas with other parents/educators and develop their own skills.

There are five values that underpin family learning, these are:

- Family learning recognises the role of the parent as the first and key educator.
- Family learning operates within a culture of mutual respect for individuals, communities, colleagues and organisations.
- Family learning is inclusive and open to all families, regardless of culture, race, relationships and beliefs.
- Family learning recognises it is ok to make mistakes, this is a valuable part of learning, the process of reflecting and improving.
- Family learning hopes to raise confidence and aspirations.

We have successfully piloted a series of Family Learning sessions at the Academy over the Autumn term.

- The family learning programme came directly from requests from parent questionnaires as well as what are the best days and times to have them.
- There has been an average of 25 parents/carers and their young people attending each session.
- We started off with 5 members of staff volunteering to be part of the planning & delivery team, this has now expanded to 11.
