### **NATIONAL E-LEARNING OFFER: E-SGOIL EASTER STUDY SUPPORT**

I'm writing to outline the e-Sgoil Senior Phase Easter Study Support programme for 2023, a key element of Scotland's National e-Learning Offer (NeLO), and to ask for your help in disseminating information about the programme to secondary schools in your Local Authority or region.

Easter Study Support will run from 3 to 14 April 2023. The programme comprises live, interactive webinars delivered by experienced, GTCS registered teachers from across Scotland. A total of 80 webinar groups are on offer this year, covering 30 subjects. Each group will meet for three separate webinar sessions.

Last year, there were over 15000 webinar registrations and learners' evaluations were overwhelmingly positive. The service is free to all learners.
