I write to you today regarding this year's SQA exam diet which is scheduled to run from

Monday 22nd April 2024 to Thursday 30 May 2024 (contingency day)

Exam timetable

At the end of this letter, you will find details of Fraserburgh Academy's Exam Timetable 2024.

For some time now, learners have been able to access a version of this timetable through the SQA website, but I would advise that although the majority of our exams will be at the same times as advertised by the SQA, I have had to change the times of some exams to fit in with our school day.

I would suggest that all learners check and are aware of the exact times of their exams and if in any doubt then please check either with myself or their subject teacher.

We are aware that some exams will end past the end of our school day on a Thursday and Friday and are currently working on this and will be in touch with those affected by this in due course.

Additional Arrangements

For some learners it is recommended that they receive Additional Arrangements dependent on their own personal circumstances. These arrangements are designed to ensure all learners have equal and fair access to exams allowing them to show their academic ability. This process is administered through our Additional Support for Learners Faculty and if your child is to receive such support, you will receive notification of this.

Please ensure that your child is aware of what support has been put in place for them.

Estimate Grades

This year, like all others, we are to submit learners estimate grades to the SQA, the deadline for this being **Thursday 18 April 2024.** This estimate grade may be considered by the SQA in the event of an **Exam Exceptional Circumstances Consideration** and will be based on demonstrated attainment, this coming from appropriate SQA level assessments completed in school under SQA standards.





Learners will be made aware of these estimate grades through a tracking report which will be issued soon after this date.

Exam Exceptional Circumstances Consideration

The SQA recognise that there are times when learners cannot sit an exam for reasons out with their control. The Examination Exceptional Circumstances Consideration Service (EECCS) will continue to be available this year, meaning those learners with exceptional circumstances can have alternative assessment evidence reviewed to help determine their grades. The EECCS is a pre-certification service and will be available to learners who are unable to attend an exam as well as those whose performance in the exam may have been affected by a personal circumstance, or an unplanned incident on the day, which is beyond their control.

To be eligible for the EECCS, learners must have completed all the compulsory non-question paper components of their course, such as performances and portfolios. They must also have an estimated grade submitted by their centre.

The EECCS is not available to learners who have underperformed on the day of the timetabled exam unless they have suffered an exceptional circumstance.

Study and Help clubs and other Study Resources

School Faculties advertise their study and support sessions through social media and on school display screens and I would advise learners to check these outlets as well as asking class teachers for information as to when support sessions are scheduled.

The SQA website is an invaluable source of past papers, exam technique guidance and other support materials and I would recommend that your child accesses this site using the link below.

The SQA are soon to publish a booklet which will be sent to all learners sitting National 5, Higher and Advanced Higher exams, and this will detail many aspects of the upcoming exams and SQA supports, and I would again encourage all to read this when it arrives.
